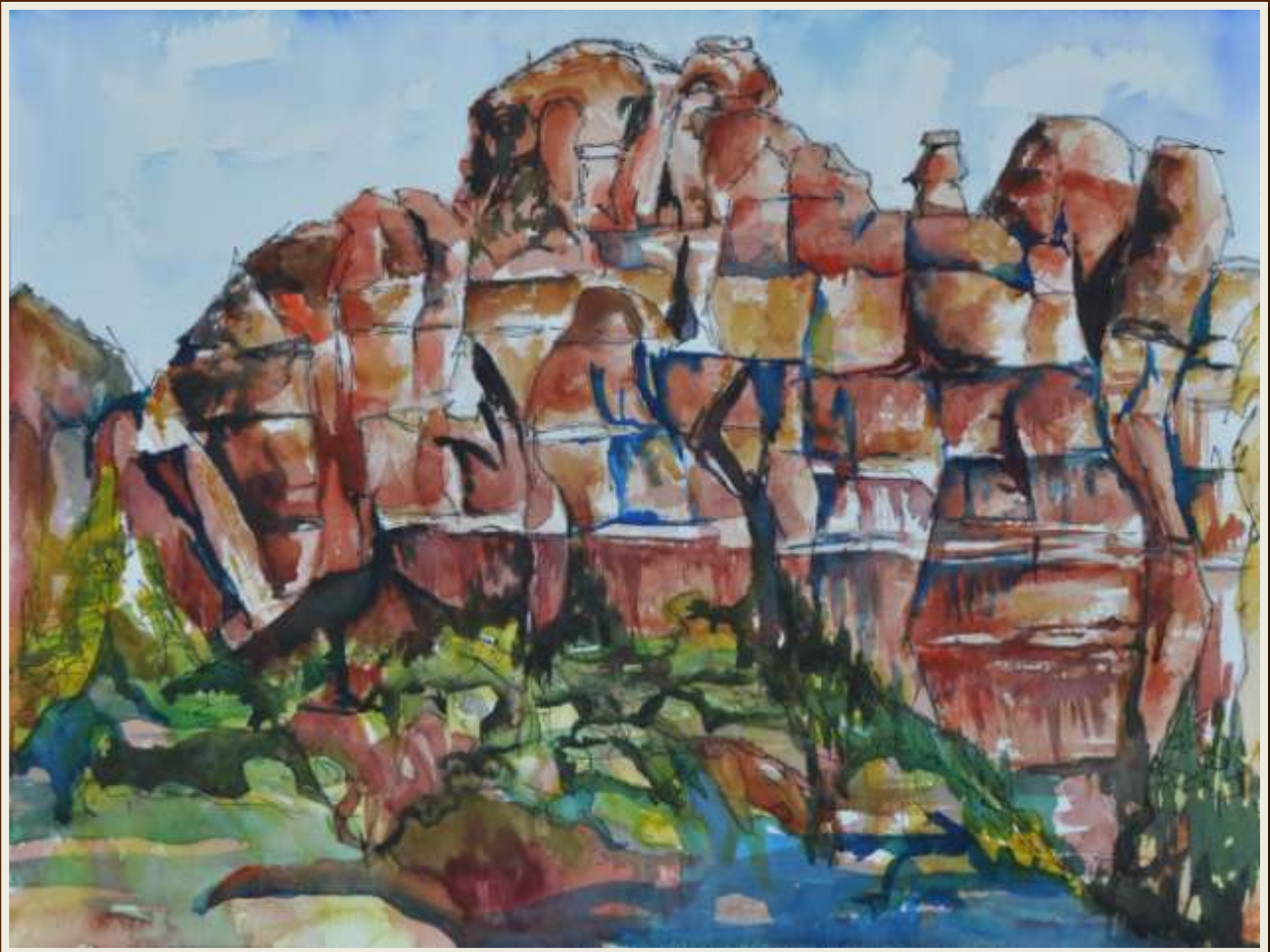

Joy's talent emerged at a time when her children were grown moving on with their own lives. She began seeking something new and meaningful in her life and painting seemed like a good choice. Her journey into the art world started with studying anything she could get her hands on about art, artists, and their chosen style and medium. She loved the "Luminosity" and "Transparency" of watercolor – enjoyed the challenge of having to "Get it right the first time," and decided her biggest challenge of all was going to be adding vibrancy to this mix. She also loves photography and finds the two mediums quite naturally merge with each other.

Born and raised in Brandon Manitoba, Canada, to an extreme climate, Joy found that her mood was often dictated by the weather. As a result, her paintings are inspired by thoughts of warm summer days with visions of light dancing on otherwise inanimate objects, seemingly bringing them to life. I try to convey this excitement through my work.

Today, Joy resides in Sedona, AZ, where she is inspired by the unique beauty that surrounds her. "Nature affords me endless opportunity for creativity and inner satisfaction, so I try to use form, line, color, and design to evoke emotions that my viewers can share."

Most days finds Joy in her studio with a paintbrush, touring around with her camera, or doing the graphic design work she loves. 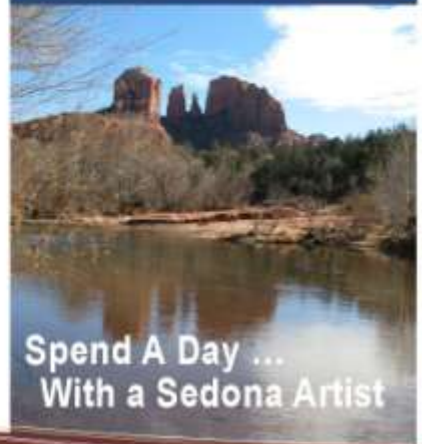

ART STUDIO TOUR

Visit 3 professional Sedona artists in their studios. See the equipment they use and view their work. Ask those questions you've always wanted to ask. An attempt will be made to accommodate a range of mediums.



GALLERY TOUR

Sedona has some of the most prestigious galleries in the world. Visit those galleries that has made Sedona so famous for their art. If coupled with the Art Studio Tour, visiting some of the studios / galleries in Jerome (a living ghost town) would be an option.



STUDIO PAINTING

Paint alongside Joy in her studio. This time can be spent with or without instruction. The choice is yours. She is prepared to freely share the techniques she uses and will work with you on areas you want to work on.



PHOTOGRAPHY

Bring your camera! This adventure will start in the studio where we will talk about color and composition—what makes a good photo vs. a weak one. We will discuss the features on a digital camera. Time will be spent toting around Sedona and working on our photography skills.



PLEIN AIR PAINTING

Paint plein air along with Joy. Your painting adventure can be with OR without instruction. The choice is yours. If the whole day is to spent painting, then we will visit 2 locations.



JEWELRY DESIGN

Spend time in the studio with Joy designing jewelry. We will talk freely about color and composition (yes this is applicable to all art forms). You will have the opportunity to design your own creation.

Paint, Brushes, Equipment, and Supplies are available for studio or plein air painting adventures.

A GRAND CANYON ART ADVENTURE ...

Spend the morning working with your camera on the East Rim of the Grand Canyon. Learn about color and composition—what makes a great shot.

Visit the Hub Studio on the South Rim, the Grand Canyon Art Gallery. The remainder of your day will be spent painting plein air OR toting the South Rim.

OR

You can paint plein air morning and afternoon, with or without instruction. YOU design your day.

Your day ends with the wonder of watching the sun set over the Grand Canyon. \$289

Sedona offers the prettiest views in the world and has been dubbed the "Outdoor painting capital in the US." Students will join Joy on location for a brief painting demonstration and a glimpse into the training, technique and thought processes necessary to paint a successful plein air painting. These classes will remain small to ensure that there is lots of time to work individually with each student.



Color

The student will learn about pigments, how to mix color, and how to create a mood with color. We will learn the technical aspects of painting while studying topics such as color wheels, color harmonies, color themes, transparency vs opacity, and varied tonal values.

Have you ever wondered what it is about a painting that makes it work? Why do you like one painting over another even though they are both technically well done? We will explore what makes a good painting in our color and composition workshops. 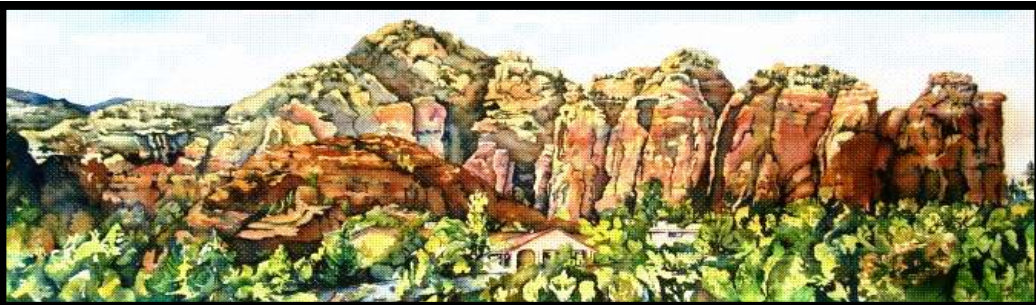

My studio door is OPEN and visitors are welcome

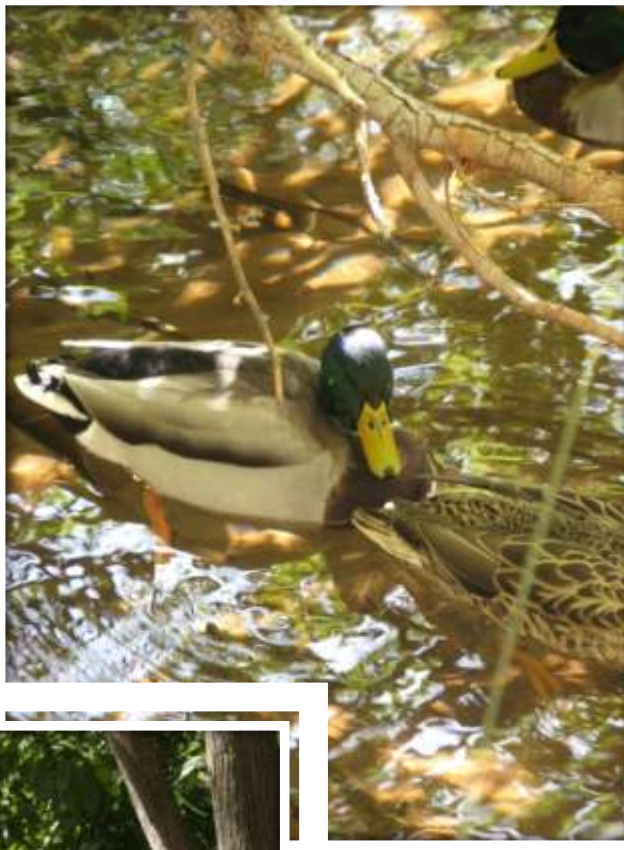
